Congratulations on your recent appointment as Minister of Education and Early Childhood Development.

I am writing to encourage you to move Bill 10: An Act to Amend the Education Act, forward. This Bill, currently referred to the Committee of the Whole, will mandate the Department of Education and Early Childhood Development to incorporate First Nations history and culture in its curricula.
