Dear Minister Horsman:

Congratulations on your recent appointment as Minister of Families and Children.

I have a high percentage of constituents who access the services of your department. Based on conversations with countless men and women in my riding it has become clear to me that we need to transform our social assistance and social housing systems so as to help people escape poverty.

Our social assistance rates are inadequate. We are in fact, perpetuating cycles of poverty, when those living on assistance are incapable of providing healthy meals, warm clothing and adequate housing for themselves and their families. I hope that you will be a champion for enhancing social assistance rates.

I also encourage you to consider resuscitating NB Housing. Currently, public housing is managed along with income assistance. Playing the role of landlord requires much more hands-on service than the department has been able to provide. The Department also lacks a comprehensive strategy to increase the amount of affordable housing in New Brunswick, a mandate that could be better handled by a revived NB Housing.

I would be happy to speak with you in more detail on these issues and any others if you so desire.
