Congratulations on your recent appointment as Minister of Transportation and Infrastructure.

I have spoken to your predecessor and his staff regarding two priority projects as the MLA for Fredericton South and the Leader of the Green Party of New Brunswick. I hope you will take up these files.

The first is a pedestrian crossing over Route 8 to connect those living in Skyline Acres, Forest Hill and Southwood Park to the university campuses and the uptown area.
